

## Conference Location

The Edo Period lasted for nearly 260 years until the Meiji Restoration in 1868, when the Tokugawa Shogunate ended and the Imperial rule was restored. The Emperor moved to Edo, which was renamed Tokyo. As the center of politics and culture in Japan, Tokyo grew into a huge city with a population of over 12 millions during the 20th century. The Tower Hall Funabori is located at the Edogawa-ku, east-end of Tokyo Metropolis. This place is just between the two international airport close to Tokyo city, Narita and Haneda.



The symbol of the Tokyo Metropolis is made up of three arcs resembling a ginkgo leaf and representing the letter T for Tokyo.




